Content

Content screen example 1

Unit > Title

Plain text (1-2 small paragraphs)

or

Bullet points (4-6 bullets of 1-2 lines each)

or

Plain text (1 paragraph) and bullet points (2-3 bullets of 1-2 lines each)

Content screen example 2 – Click to reveal

Unit > Title

Click on each concept for more information. [Instruction]

- Concept 1 *[link]*
- Concept 2 *[link]*
- Concept 3 *[link]*
- ...

Information for concept 1 (one small paragraph)

Comment: *A small paragraph (2-3 lines) could be included also before or after the bullet points. Concepts could be just a word or a small phrase. The text is revealed on the same screen. This is a common type of interactivity and a great way to break long texts.*

Specifications

- **Image resolution:** Images should not be less than 2048px. This means that the width or the height (or both) of each image should be more than 2048px.
